**Restarting kindergarten and primary school**

- From Monday 8 June 2020, all classes and years of study will again be able to come to school full time. There will be classes on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. On Wednesday there is **NO** class, only emergency shelter.
- The start and end hours are as follows:
  - **5th and 6th year::**
    - entrance and exit via Kleemputtenstraat.
    - The school day starts at 8h20 and ends at 14h50.
  - **Kindergarten and L1:**
    - entrance and exit via Kleemputtenstraat.
    - The school day starts at 8.30 am and ends at 3 pm.
  - **2nd, 3rd and 4th grade:**
    - entrance and exit via **Molenstraat**.
    - The school day starts at 8.40 am and ends at 3.10 pm.
  - **General:**
    - The buildings are supervised from 8.00 am onwards.
    - If you have children in different class/learning years, they may of course come to school together at the same time and through 1 particular entrance.
    - Before we go home, we strictly follow the planned exit. If your child is allowed to go home independently (or to the exit), we ask you to write this down in your diary or a note.
    - The domain is still 'forbidden' territory for parents unless you have an appointment with a staff member, for example. We ask parents to wear a mouth mask as much as possible and to keep enough distance. We note that this is fairly well followed up, thank you for that!



### Pre- and after-school care and emergency shelter on Wednesdays

- We find that there are children in the pre and after care who were not enrolled. After contacting the parents involved, we understand that for some of them it is difficult to estimate the use/time of these children. It was therefore decided that there is **no** longer any need to register for the pre and after-care and we return to the system as it used to be. Sufficient staff will be provided.
- The use of the pre- and after-care remains paying (*rate: 1,15 euro per started half hour*). The hours are as follows:
  - o Pre-care: 7h00 to 8h00
  - o Aftercare: 15h30 to 17h30
  - o On Wednesday aftercare: 12h00 to 14h00
- On Wednesdays there is no school but we do organize emergency shelter for parents who have no other solution. For this you do need to register. This can be done via the following link:

### Traffic situation Kleemputtenstraat

- The kindergarten started on Tuesday and yesterday the first rain fell from the sky. We notice that because of this more parents bring their child to school by car.  
A combination of both factors yesterday caused the traffic situation in the Kleemputtenstraat and on our car park to be far from optimal. This causes the necessary frustrations between parents, traffic unsafe situations and traffic jams as a result.
- We ask all parents again:
  - o Do not park on the small parking lot when it is full (see picture). Because of the many maneuvers a lot of damage has already been done to the fence (which will be replaced soon).
  - o Respect the traffic rules as much as possible. A parking space may not have priority over the safety of children and other parents.
- We hope that the traffic volume in the Kleemputtenstraat will decrease by turning the Molenstraat back into the entrance and exit for the 2nd, 3rd and 4th grade.
- The police zone TARL was asked to call in increased police supervision.
- We are also in consultation with the municipality to find a solution during the start and end hours of the school day (e.g. by dynamic one-way, extended kiss&ride, ...).
