Financial - invoices received

There is some confusion with some parents about the invoices sent by the central services of our Scholengroep. As there were no more excursions, it was decided to make all the payments for the **maximum invoice** (lower: 90 euro / toddler: 45 euro) for the current school year. Since there have been no trips for a long period of time, this means that this is a positive result for most parents. If the red strip is **empty**, money will be refunded to your account.



Important: if you send your child to pre-school and after-school care, you will receive an invoice at the beginning of next month. Those who still have outstanding payments will also be contacted in the course of the following days.

Wearing a mouth mask when picking up your child(ren)

We notice that fewer and fewer parents wear a mouth mask when entering the school grounds. We understand that the federal government has announced relaxations and as a result certain agreements are blurred and/or no longer clear. However, stricter guidelines remain in force for schools, which we ask them to respect.



May we ask all parents to wear a mouth mask when picking up their child and to respect social distancing as much as possible!



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22-26 June 2020 - Targeted parent contacts kindergarten

- During this week the teachers of the kindergarten carry out their **targeted** parent contacts. This can be done via a live session, by telephone or physically after school. There are no general parent contacts to limit the physical presence of parents on the school grounds.
- We ask all parents to wear a mouth mask in case of physical contact at the school grounds.
- The class teacher will invite the parent(s) he/she wishes to speak to. This will mainly be via smartschool, but can also be done by telephone or via a note.
- If you do not receive a message, this means that there are no specific concerns that need to be communicated. If you do wish to speak to the teacher, it suffices to contact him/her (via Smartschool, notebook, secretariat, ...). We will then look into the matter together to make an appointment.

Monday 29 June 2020 - Targeted parent contacts primary school L1-L5

- General:
 - Is a 'normal' school day (L5/6 to 14h50 Toddler/L1 to 15h L2/3/4 to 15h10).
 - Throughout the day there will be time to take a class photo with the class teacher(s). Afterwards, we will send this digitally to all parents via Smartschool. One does not have to pay anything for this. This is as a reminder for parents, pupils and teachers.

- Targeted parent contacts primary school (L1-L5):

- The primary school teachers will carry out their **targeted** parent contacts on **Monday 29 June 2020.** This can be done via a live session, by telephone or physically after school hours. There are no general parent contacts to limit the physical presence of parents in the school domain.
- We ask all parents to wear a mouth mask in case of physical contact at school.
- The class teacher will make an appointment with the parent(s) he/she wishes to speak to in the week of 22-26 June 2020. This will mainly be via smartschool but can also be done by telephone or by a note.
- If you do not receive a message, this means that there are no specific concerns that need to be communicated. If you do wish to speak to the teacher, it suffices to contact him/her (via Smartschool, class diary, secretariat, ...). We will then look into the matter together to make an appointment.
- Only exception class L4A: due to a concurrence of circumstances, there has not yet been optimal parental contact for this class since January. Miss Katrien will communicate separately with the parents of this class and will offer the possibility of a general parental contact.

- Moment keys L6:

The 6th grade always organizes a moment for parents to look into the tests. Because this also has to be done with the necessary guidelines, they will work on Ma 29/06 by appointment. You will also receive specific communication via the classroom teachers.

Tuesday 30 June 2020 - last day of school



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- The school day lasts for all students until the original hour (L5/6 to 14h50 Toddler/L1 to 15h L2/3/4 to 15h10). The pre-course (from 7 am) and after-care (until 5.30 pm) remains guaranteed.
- There will be classes until noon. In the afternoon the class will finish the school year with his/her teacher.
- During the afternoon playtime, all children will be treated to an ice cream in their bubble on behalf of the school and the parents' committee 'De Bij' (The Bee).
- Between 15h and 17h, parents can drop by again without any obligation, for example to say goodbye, hand over a gift, There is no need to make an appointment. Here, too, parents are asked to wear a mouth mask and to keep the social distancing.

Summer school municipality Liedekerke

- Liedekerke organizes again summer school from 27/7 to 7/8 (2 weeks).

- The focus is on language and especially on writing, reading and speaking exercises in Dutch.
- Expansion this school year (once only due to the corona measures)!
 - This year toddlers are also welcome (they have to start in K2 after the summer). Sanitation is a must.
 - Children who are Dutch-speaking at home, but who have school arrears due to the corona measures, are also welcome.
- The classroom teacher will examine to what extent this school disadvantage can be a problem next school year and/or where the summer school can offer an extra supplement in terms of language stimulation.
- If your child would qualify, the class teacher will discuss this with the parents and hand over a referral form.
 Only with this form you can make use of this offer. Parents can use this form to register at the Vrijetijdshuis (Library) where they will be further assisted.



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
