

Letter in English (translation program)

Dear Parent (s)

I just received the message that a student from your son / daughter's class has tested positive for COVID-19.

In view of this report, our COVID procedure was started. There has been contact between our school, the CLB doctor and the crisis cell of our School Group.

The CLB has conducted a contact investigation and has established that contacts **high-risk** have taken place. Your child falls under this category. The e-mail below therefore applies to you.

The doctor has decided that a number of students must be quarantined until Monday 22/02/21.

Additional information:

- Your child must be tested twice (1st time on 15/02 and 2nd time on 19/02). You will receive these codes via SMS from the CLB. You will receive the first code this evening. If this is not the case, please contact us as soon as possible. You can have the test carried out at a test center or at the family doctor.
- If the 2nd test result is negative before the end of the spring break, your child can return to school on Monday 22/02/21 and the quarantine period will expire. Keep in mind the guidelines in the accompanying letter from the CLB.
