## As a school, we attach great importance to your presence and involvement. We therefore find it very important that you are present at this time.

**Important to know!** The language of instruction for this contact moment is Dutch. If you do not speak the language, we ask you to bring an interpreter or confidential adviser.



## How do you make an appointment?

- Create via **Smartschool module parent contact** an <u>online appointment</u> with the teacher. You can check there which times are still available.

- If you have problems with your Smartschool account, you can contact the secretariat on **053 / 46.33.00**. <u>They will make an appointment with you by telephone.</u>
- We ask you to make time for the parent contact on the scheduled date. If you are still unable to come by, you can contact the class teacher (via Smartschool, by telephone, via the agenda, ...). An alternative moment can then be agreed mutually.
- Given the current health crisis, it is possible to conduct the parent contact **via a live session**. If you wish, you must arrange this yourself with the class teacher. He / she will make an appointment with you via Smartschool for a live parent contact.

## **COVID-19** guidelines during the parent contact:

- During a physical contact with the parent, wear a **mouth mask** and keep **sufficient distance** (at least 1.5 meters) from other parents, children and staff.
- When you enter a building you **disinfected hands**.
- There is always a different entrance and exit per building so that people do not cross each other.
- **Respect it provided hour of appointment** and **be timely present** at your appointment. In this way we avoid parents having to wait (too long) in the hallway.
- Limit (if possible) the presence of the parent contact to 1 parent.
- Per building will be one waiting area where you are seated on safe away can wait for your turn. We ask you to take a seat here and not wait at the classroom.
