Last Saturday, the Flemish government decided in consultation with education partners and virologists that education in code ORANGE will remain until the mid-term holidays. masks in primary education - extension of the spring break The Flemish government has not yet taken a position on further measures such as the mandatory mouth mask in primary education, extension of the spring break, and an expert group will consider plan B. The evolution in the corona figures will play a crucial role in further action. We will hear more about this shortly.

For our school it is simple: we follow current regulations and government decisions.

We are therefore currently not taking any further measures unless the situation no longer permits it (eg corona outbreak in a certain class, causing mouth masks to be introduced there). Health measures are always taken in consultation with the CLB doctors and the prevention service of our School Group.

Tightening of corona rules for travelers

On Wednesday, December 30, 2020, the corona rules for travelers were tightened.

Anyone who returns from a red zone and has stayed there for more than 48 hours, will be required to be in quarantine for at least 7 days from 31 December. You will also need to have a corona test on Day 1 and Day 7 after your return. You are only allowed out of quarantine if you pass a negative PCR test after 7 days. The measure applies to Belgians and non-Belgians and will last at least until January 15th.

In order to prevent the spread of the virus and to protect the children and staff members at our school, it is important to respect these new stricter travel rules.

So we are introducing increased vigilance for disease symptoms of the coronavirus.


These symptoms are: excessive coughing, shortness of breath, fatigue, stuffy nose, sore throat, loss of smell and taste, diarrhea,
